

# Participation of civil society and citizen

- creates more confidence in the end of the results and to the institutions delivering policies? (European Governance White paper, 2001)

# Knowledge and opinion of fishers toward LO

Never heard about LO
because nobody informed
us "and "we didn't have
the opportunity to express
our opinion about it" (EL
fisher)

When the idea of a landing obligation, or discard ban (...) was first proposed by the Commission I, (...) thought the worst, that it could never work." (IE fisher)

# Do we miss the right arguments to convince fishers?

EU didn't find the right words and arguments to explain such unjust decision" (FR manager) "fishers cannot understand the reasons of such policy and reject LO (...). They don't even want to discuss about it. Now it is too late to change this negative perception of EU and LO" (FR Manager)


# Opinion of *French fishe*rs about LO by size of vessels

	Vessels >12m of length	Vessels <12 m length

Very good	9	7
Without opinion	1	4


### **Economic impact by gear (number of vessels)**

As it stands, the LO will produce a lot of problems on board. (IE fisher)

if you make a trawl and you have boarfish your hold is full and you go back to port (FR fisher) And whom will pay for the extra cost (ice, boxes, auction fees, gears ??) etc.. (Fr, EL, ES...)




### Greece

"we prefer to sort at the bottom of the sea than on the deck of the ship"


## Resistance until when?

"Better not to start register discards because, as soon they do it, they don't have the possibility to back out".

"I will never start registering discard until I get a fine"

2019: Few evolutions noticed

- Fishers started to register discards in some areas (FR)
- Fishers start landing discards (IE)



Need of data to negotiate
"Without data on discards, it is difficult
to convince decisions-makers about the
impossibility to implement and apply
LO"

Avoid seeing boats nailed to fishing harbors due to choke species

Fishers more open to test more selective gears
